*The Fulbright Program provides about 7,500 annual grants to undertake graduate study, advanced research, university lecturing, and classroom teaching. Since the program began, approximately 300,000 people - 111,000 from the United States and 183,000 from other countries - have participated. The US-India Educational Foundation has administered over 17,000 grants for Indians and U.S. citizens. Grantees' fields of study span the fine arts, humanities, social sciences, mathematics, natural and physical sciences, and professional and applied sciences. Information will be given about the nature of the program, opportunities and how to apply for one of the grants.*
