CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. The contract is purely for year from the date of issue of work order and likely to be extended on satisfactory performance.
2. It is the responsibility of the Contractor to wear safety equipment's. Take necessary precaution while working.
3. It is the responsibility of the Contractor to cover the works, under any valid insurance scheme (Accident policy) and provide a copy to us.
4. It is the responsibility of the Contractor to take care of workers and machinery to avoid any accidents. Institute will not be responsible for any such incidents.
5. Payment will be made once in a month against satisfactory certificate from HOD/SIC.
6. It is the responsibility of the Contractor to depute someone in case of absence of any one of the workers. The contractor can depute another person, only with approval from HOD, engineering services. No person should be changed with a minimum period of 6 months on normal conditions.
7. Under no circumstances waste should be stored more than one day at the storage area.
8. It is the duty of the Contractor to remove ash as and when required and to deposit it in specified location, cleaning the premises, machine and to take care of day to day and periodic maintenance and cleaning.
9. The Contractor has to produce recent 5 years or more working experience certificate or copy of work order along with the quotation.
10. Minor repair, minor maintenance or preventive maintenance of the incinerator will be treated as duty as evaluated by the Engineer in charge.
11. Applicable taxes will be deducted from the bill.
12. The Contractor has to enter into an agreement to The Director, SCTIMST on 200/- Rupees stamp paper before commencement of work.
13. Institute has the right to cancel the contract at any time without notice.
14. It is the responsibility of contractor to have proper vaccinations while working in the incinerator.
15. The contractors having hands on experience in operation, preventive maintenance, minor repair etc for at least 5 years (minimum) shall apply.
16. Operation/maintenance should be at day or night shifts as required by the Institute.
17. There must be a main operator and an assistant throughout in operation
